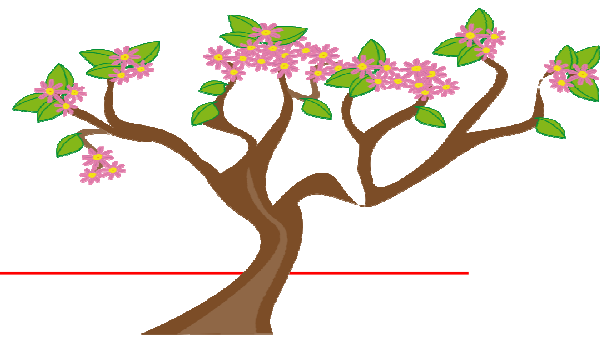

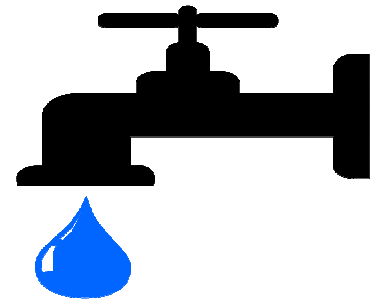
The 3rd Tuesday of each month the Mayor is available at Coloma City Hall from 2:30 ~ 4:00 pm.
